


## Focus in EU grid planning must be on legitimacy, not acceptance

---

### Acceptance – ideal case

„I embrace the details of the final decision as my own.“

### Legitimacy – second best

„I do not like the final decision, but I accept the decision-making process.“

### Policy


How should the energy system look like?

How should grid planning be done, who decides what?


### Technical planning

## Many actors contribute to various processes in EU grid planning




## 3 key solutions to achieve legitimacy in EU grid planning and support local acceptance



## 3 key solutions to achieve legitimacy in EU grid planning and support local acceptance

- 1 Consistent objectives
- 2 Transparency & participation in planning
- 3 Leverage EU environmental legislation

### Involve civil society representatives

---

Establish stakeholder group representing

- Environment
- Citizens rights
- Consumers

Initial topics

- Environmental concerns
- Social acceptance
- Scenarios and sensitivities

Direct actions

- Establish ENTSO-E contact persons
- Pose clear questions and timeline
- Show how feedback is used

### Increase transparency

---

Institutional improvement

- Establish "TYNDP transparency & participation officer"
- Publish "Transparency progress report"
- Include external evaluation

Specific content

- Explain and discuss criteria "social and environmental impact" better

### Continuous learning

---

Identify and exchange **best practices** on national planning processes:

- Transparency
- Stakeholder involvement & dialogue
- Environmental assessment

## Energy Infrastructure Regulation – Amendments in ITRE draft report supported by RGI

---

### **Proactive environmental planning to speed-up grid development**

**Amendment 49** (de Campos), **442** (Jadot): Monitor the implementation of streamlined permitting procedures

**Amendment 78** (de Campos), **619** (Jadot): Reporting on implementation – identification of good practices with regard to stakeholder involvement and mitigation of environmental impact

**Amendment 442** (Jadot): Ensure national authorities have sufficient capacity to streamline EIAs

### **Strengthening support to win public acceptance at the project level**

**Amendment 78** (de Campos), **619** (Jadot): Reporting on implementation – identification of good practices with regard to stakeholder involvement and mitigation of environmental impact

### **Improving participation and transparency in Regional Groups**


**Amendment 700** (Jadot): Grant observer status to NGOs in regional groups

**Amendment 721** (Jadot): Delete unnecessary restriction of scope for consultation of stakeholders in regional groups

### **Strengthen long term planning in grid development**

**Amendment 275** (Jadot, Sosa, Wagner): Emphasise “long term” perspective in the criteria to select project of common interest
