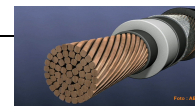

FARMERS: highest impact, losses of earnings, better compensation
higher temperature at the floor surface

Country sovereignty

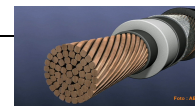
TSO 's: no compromises,

insignificant theme in all parties

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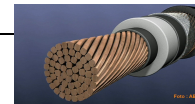
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red = no; yellow = neutral; green = good

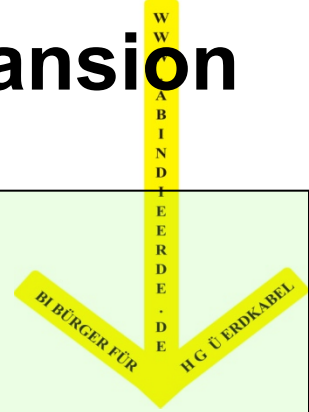


Requirement for Participation in Grid Expansion



- early beginning **dialog** with the public,
- creating the greatest possible **transparency** incl. demand planning,
- fairly **communication** at eye level
- professional **mediators** (analog Stuttgart 21)
- **Compensation** according to volume putting through,
- **Installation** of the latest technologies,
- **Citizens ‘ Vote** as last chance in participation
- **Citizens ‘** Partizipation as **Shareholder**

2 Instances at court of
justice

=> Traditional formaly,
slow, inefficient,

Before 2012

Repeal of federalism
only one authority (BNetzA)

Implementation of „NEP ‘s“
(grid development plans made by
TSO ‘s and verified by universities)

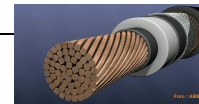
3 scenario frames in 2 future time
horizonts incl. National Economic
forecasts and Revision/Revolving
every two years

Only one instance in contradiction

2015 new law (Erdkabelgesetz)

=> More transparency, much faster,
much better
