
EUROPEAN GRID REPORT

BEYOND PUBLIC OPPOSITION — LESSONS LEARNED ACROSS EUROPE 10 SELECTED PRACTICAL EXPERIENCES





In 2011, under the guidance of the Renewables-Grid-Initiative (RGI), a coalition of Europe's 29 largest environmental NGOs and TSOs pledged to work in partnership to ensure that the goals of grid modernisation and environmental protection can be achieved side by side. The European Grid Declaration (EGD) was publicly signed in Brussels. In 2012, the EGD has been extended by principles covering transparency and public participation.

Many of the principles and ideas covered by both parts of the EGD are already being considered and tested by RGI members. Throughout 2012, RGI has collected practical steps taken to make grid development quicker, more socially acceptable, and increasingly environmentally sound. This map higlights 10 examples from across Europe covering six different themes.
