We enable discussions on how to model, plan and implement decarbonised and optimised clean energy systems, including different voices in the process.




#### **Environmental**

- 3. Discuss and agree on the definition of climate adaptation and resilience measures with the purpose of its implementation in the ENTSO-E CBA assessment framework.
- 4. Discuss how adaptation measures could be assessed to enable comparison with 'other solutions which do not require new infrastructure'.
