So far: **Best Practice** Project

→ Reporting of self-selected **individual success stories**

New: **Monitoring**

→ **Comprehensive analysis** of progress

→ Consideration of **external factors**

→ Systematic identification of **potential for improvement**

→ Enhanced visibility/credibility for external stakeholders



Key principles

- Joint performance monitoring – focus on interdependence of all three actors
- Cross assessment and review



Monitoring framework

Assessment of key players in different project phases plus cross-cutting elements
